Rules & regs

Plans are moving ahead for the 2003 *Autosport* Caterham Eurocup season and, we're pleased to say, interest levels are running high from competitors with R400s and Roadsports from all the many championships.

The championship regulations will be published very soon. In the meantime, here is a potted synopsis of what's eligible:

Caterham R400s

Cars complying with the regulations of the 2003 Caterham R400 Challenge, with the addition of a catalytic converter and the required Yokohama racing tyres.

Caterham Roadsports

A somewhat more free class designed to attract Roadsports from all over Europe, not just the UK. Cars currently competing in the Roadsport Challenge A and B classes are eligible, as well as those from the Caterham Super-Graduates Championship.

Competitors from these championships may run their cars "as is" – although again Yokohama tyres and a catalytic converter are mandatory – or they may if they wish take advantage of further freedoms, including removal of lamps and screens.

Licence requirement

A National A licence is required for both R400 and Roadsport classes.

Championship registration

This is what it will cost...

R400s

Championship registration: £600.

Free to drivers already registered in the Caterham R400 Challenge. £100 for drivers already registered to the German Caterham championship.

Race entry fees: £1,800 in advance or £400 per meeting. *The option to pay for all five meetings in advance at the reduced price expires on 31 March.*

Roadsports

Championship registration: £300.

Free to drivers already registered in the Caterham Roadsport Challenge. £100 for drivers already registered to the German Caterham championship or the Caterham Super-Graduates.

Race entry fees: £1,800 in advance or £400 per meeting.

The option to pay for all five meetings in advance at the reduced price expires on 31 March.

European Trophy

As you may have spotted in our media announcement last week, Caterham is organising a very special European event at Spa-Francorchamps in August.

It will support not only the British GTs and F3s but also the FIA Sportscar Championship and will be open to any kind of Caterham.

Firm date has yet to be announced, but it will be either the weekend of August 23/24 or 30/31, with two races and a low entry fee. It's not a championship round, so tyres will be free.
