Remember all these times are provisional. It is the competitor's responsibility to watch the progress of the meeting and to be in the race assembly area no later than 10 mins prior to the start of qualifying/race.

### PRIZE GIVING

Roadsport B prize giving will be approx 30 mins after Race 6 just before lunch, and Roadsport A after race 10 around 4.30, both presentations to take place in Garage 7. Please do remember that if there is a delay in getting times because of an incident this may cause a delay in prize giving. Due to the fact that I will probably be in race control sorting out the incident I will not be in the paddock to tell you that prize giving will be postponed. I will try and inform your driver reps who will contact as many of you as possible. But of course there will be no incidents so prize giving will always be on time!!

Trophies will not be given out at the end of each race, so when the race has finished all of you are to leave the circuit via the pit lane and into Parc Ferme. There has been a lot of confusion in the past at the end of a race trying to find drivers to come and collect their trophies, this should not arise now.
