## **TECHNICAL**

Weight seems to be one of the biggest issues so far, getting it right is vitally important as some of you have found out to your cost. Don't forget that fuel plays an important part; a litre of fuel weighs 0.75kg. In sprints and hillclimbs there is a possibility of you getting a re-run and you must allow for this in your fuel calculations. Also bear in mind that if you lose a wing or similar, this will reduce the weight of your car and you must allow for that also.
