#### POWERTRAIN CATERHAM CHALLENGE

The Sporting and Technical Regulations are well on the way to being finalised and for your benefit a Technical Bulletin is attached to this Newsletter. It is hoped that the new tyres will be available in February. I can confirm that three meetings in 2005 will again be on the prestigious F3/GT Package and these are:
