CADWELL

Some of you may know that this is the 10th Anniversary of the Caterham Academy, and you are privileged to be amongst the 500 or so drivers that have taken part in this very special Championship. As part of the celebration of this fantastic achievement, there will be TV cameras at Cadwell following your progress, so please be on your best behaviour and make sure you and your cars are spotlessly clean and tidy! ROADSPORT Inter and B 2006

Current pre registration lists attached. You will see that Roadsport B is full! Some of you should consider entering the Inter Class, which does provide extra value racing for a modest upgrade price of around £1,000.

You will be eligible to enter the Eurocup, licence requirement not confirmed as yet, but will be a minimum National A (which is 6 upgrade signatures on your National B). You will be competing at some of Europe's finest circuits, e.g. Spa, Nurburgring, Hockenheim, Dijon, and of course the weather is usually good too! This year there were 6 double headed events with 2 x 20 min qualifying and 2 x 25 mins races.

Back to England, races will be 30 mins instead of 20, and of course you will get quicker lap times! Lots of reasons for you to upgrade.
