2002 championship registration forms

The sporting and technical regulations for both the Superlight Challenge and the Eurocup and currently working their way through the bureaucratic system, but I know that many of you are keen to register and book your place on the grid for 2002.

With this in mind, Caterham has issued driver pre-registration forms for both championships, which you should receive with this newsletter.

As you will have noticed from last month's newsletter, the championship registration fee for the 2002 Superlight Challenge will be £500; paying this fee will also entitle the registered driver to race in the Eurocup with no further championship registration fees payable. Also, once a driver has registered for the Superlight Challenge, his car may be taken over by another driver for one or more Superlight Challenge races without them being required to pay a further fee.

However, please note there will be one very strictly enforced championship rule, even though no further money may be changing hands:

ALL drivers must register with the co-ordinator not less than 1 week before practice of the first round being entered for the championship by returning the registration form. If an entrant wishes to nominate more than one driver during the

course of the season he must complete one registration form for each driver.

There will be no exceptions to this rule...

Superlight drivers

If you're planning to contest even one round of the Eurocup, please help us by filling in the Eurocup championship registration form at the same time as your Superlight paperwork...

Roadsport drivers

The Eurocup is open to you, too, this year, and drivers registered for the Roadsport Challenge won't have to pay any extra championship registration fees either. Drivers of any other 1.6 K-engined Caterhams are welcome in Europe also; provided, of course, that they comply with the regulations; championship registration fee for them is £300. Any drivers not wishing to contest all five Eurocup meetings may register to contest individual events at a cost of £150 per meeting. Please note that this is addition to any race entry fees.

Race numbers

The rules are these: *Registration numbers will be permanent competition numbers for the championship. Numbers will be allocated on request using a first-come-first-served basis until the end of February 2002, with priority given to drivers who competed in the 2001 Caterham Superlight Challenge wishing to retain their 2001 numbers. The only exception will be the number 1 which will be reserved for the 2001 championship winner. Should the current champion not re-register for the series the number one will not be allocated to any competitor during the season. From 1 March competition numbers will be allocated by the co-ordinator.*

The message is: if you want a particular number, get your registration form back to us ASAP...
