REGULATIONS

By now you should have all received your championship regulations, together with a 3-page final amendment bulletin. Please read these very carefully and thoroughly.

MINISTER RACING ENGINES

Also enclosed with your regulations is a statement of policy from Minister Racing Engines our Championship appointed engine builder.

Graham Fuller from Minister has also very kindly decided to continue with the ever popular '**Minister Driver of the Day Award**'. Awarded at each race, this generous award will be presented to the most impressive performance of the day in Roadsports A and B.

AVON TYRES

You have all received tyre fitting instructions and diagram. If you have not, please let me know.

Robert Meaton from Avon has confirmed that the Avon truck will be at all rounds of our Championship.

EUROCUP

Don't forget that registered Roadsport competitors are permitted free registration to the Autosport Caterham Eurocup, which offers great racing opportunities in Europe. Spa on 17/18 May and Nurburgring 18-20 October do not clash with Championship dates and are open to those of you with National A licence.

The only change to the car would be the adoption of a catalytic converter and a switch to Yokohama treaded tyres.

In addition to the Club briefings, there will be an extra briefing for Caterham Roadsport drivers, Class A and B, as this is the first race of the season! This will probably be given after the main briefing, please listen to the PA system.

Nick Carter, Caterham's media chappie will be at Combe to take mug shots of you all. The best time to do this would be after qualifying, so Class B would be around midday and Class A around 12.20. Nick has suggested outside the Roadsport B hospitality unit.
